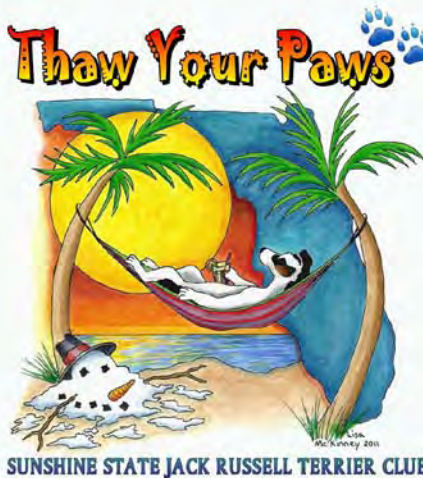

## **BRUSH HUNT**

Can your terrier find the quarry? Time starts when the handler releases the terrier in the brush area. After one minute, handler may assist the terrier in locating the quarry. **JUDGE** determines when the terrier locates and/or works the quarry.

Class 150 - Puppy - 6 to 12 months

Class 151 - Adult - 1 year and over

Class 152 - Veteran - 6 years and over

**Class 153 - Brush Hunt Champion and Reserve** - *No entry fee.*

*Awarded to 1st and 2nd fastest times each day, classes 150-152.*



## **THUNDER TUNNEL**

Similar to the EARTH DOG COMPETITION as seen on cable TV's Animal Planet, this is a timed event/competition with the terrier working their way through an above the ground tunnel. The tunnel has a clear front that allows you to see how your dog maneuvers the tunnel. The terrier runs the course twice; the better of two times is the final time posted.

Class 154 - Pups - 6 up to 12 months, up to 12 ½"

Class 155 - Pups - 6 up to 12 months, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 156 - Adults - 1 year and over, up to 12 ½"

Class 157 - Adults - 1 year and over, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 158 - Veterans - 6 years and over, up to 12 ½"

Class 159 - Veterans - 6 years and over, 12 ½" up to 15"

**Class 160 - Thunder Tunnel Champion and Reserve** - *No entry fee.*

*Awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest times each day of classes 154-159.*



## **SSJRTC POKER RUN**

- The cost for this event is \$10 per dog.
- You can enter as many dogs as you like.
- You need at least 2 cards per dog to make a hand. **NOT TO EXCEED 5 PLAYING CARDS PER DOG!**
- The more classes your dog is entered in the better your odds are to win.
- Participating dogs will receive a playing card for each class in which they are entered.
- If you enter multiple dogs you cannot combine cards to improve your poker hand. Each card will be marked with the name of the dog that entered on that card.
- Cards will be issued for paid classes only. You will not get additional cards if your dog is moved to a championship class.
- If your dog is not entered in five classes and you would like to get additional cards you can pay for additional runs at the non-sanctioned events to receive another card; Thunder Tunnel, Lure Coursing, and Brush Hunt. Additional runs will not qualify for a ribbon.
- There will be a steward at each event. Once your dog has completed the event he/she will be checked off and you will receive a specifically marked playing card with your dog's name written on the card.
- All decks will be pre-shuffled and all cards will be pulled from the top of the deck.
- To play you must enter a dog in the class numbered below for this event.
- At the end of the day we will have a winner after ribbons are handed out. 50% of all the proceeds will go to SSJRTC fund-raising and the other 50% will go to the winners: 70% to a "Champion" and 30% to a "Reserve Champion".

**Class 161 – SSJRTC Poker Run** – Open to any Terrier

## GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRT's in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if the have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Breeders\*, Open or Working Conformation.  
**\*Note:** For Breeders Classes, Brood Bitches & Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA judge may not be shown under that judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or a member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth handling classes. If an Affiliate sponsored trial is chaired by Committee, all on the committee may enter their terriers in any phase of the competition.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the Judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Only JRTCA height cards issued AFTER September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors' participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground & Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. *No liberty leashes allowed.*
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRT's on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website ([www.terrier.com](http://www.terrier.com)).

### **RULES continued**

21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. THE JUDGES DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

### **Directions to Florida Horse Park – Ocala, FL**

From I-75 – Take exit 341 head east on CR484. Continue on 484 for about 2 miles. Take a left onto S Hwy 475. Continue on 475 for 2.2 miles. The Florida Horse Park is on the left hand side. There will be SSJRTC Trial Signs Posted.

**From the Members, Board of Directors and Officers of the Sunshine State Jack Russell Terrier Club**

Class 130 - Youth Handler Go-To-Ground - Open to any youth aged 10 to 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot novice liner: time not to be considered.

Class 131 - Youth Handler Agility (On-Lead) - Open to any youth aged 10 to 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Agility. Time not to be considered.

Class 132 - Youth Handler Agility (Off-Lead) - Open to any youth aged 10 to 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Agility. Time not to be considered. **May NOT cross-enter in class 133.**

Class 133 - Youth Working Judge's Choice - Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class

Class 134 - Youth Handler High Score Champion & Reserve - Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in class 129, 130, 131 OR 132 & 133. The points are awarded as follows, 1<sup>st</sup> = 8 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 6 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 5 points, 4<sup>th</sup> = 4 points, 5<sup>th</sup> = 3points, 6<sup>th</sup> = 2points, and participation = 1 point. No Entry Fee.

## **Division G: Trailing & Locating**

- Free Practice on Saturday after competition
- The terrier is judged on its ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate & mark quarry

Class 135 - Puppies - 6 to 12 months

Class 136 - Adults - 1 year and over

Class 137 - Veterans - 6 years and over

Class 138 - Trailing & Locating Champion & Reserve - No entry fee.

*Fastest times and fewest penalties of classes 135-137.*

## **Division H: (Non-Sanctioned Events)**

**Non-Sanctioned classes are open to any dogs up to 15 inches.**

*\$10 entry fees accepted the day of the trial.*

Class 139 - Pups - 6 up to 12 months, up to 12 ½"

Class 140 - Pups - 6 up to 12 months, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 141 - Shorties - under 10"

Class 142 - Adults - 1 year and over, up to 12 ½"

Class 143 - Adults - 1 year and over, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 144 - Veterans - 6 years and over, up to 12 ½"

Class 145 - Veterans - 6 years and over, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 146 - Seniors - 9 years and over, up to 12 ½"

Class 147 - Seniors - 9 years and over, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 148 - UNDER Champion and Reserve - No entry fee.

*Awarded to 1st and 2nd fastest times each day, classes 139,141, 142, 144 & 146.*

Class 149 - OVER Champion and Reserve - No entry fee.

*Awarded to 1st and 2nd fastest times each day, classes 140, 143, 145 & 147.*



## **AGILITY continued...**

**Class 122 - Novice On-Lead, Non-Certificate** - Open to terriers that have not scored above 190 points. This class is for the true beginner terrier with the intent of a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers that drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles. Although this class is for the beginner terrier, you need to have prior exposure to agility equipment. May not cross-enter in off-lead classes.

**Class 123 - Agility I Certificate** - Open to any adult terrier. The Agility I Certificates are earned with three scores of 190 or above. Three qualifying scores may move entrant of this class on to Agility II, Agility III, and Jumpers/Game. No cross entering to this class from Agility II and Agility III. This course is used for the Youth On-Lead. No seesaw or tire jump in this class.

**Class 124 - Agility II Certificate** - More difficult course to include all of the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, weave poles, and seesaw. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility II Certificate.

**Class 125 - Agility III Certificate** - Course to include all Agility I and II equipment. Weave poles are increased to 12 and must end in a "gamble". Qualifying score will be 200 points. Gamble to be set at 8 to 10 feet.

**Class 126 – Jumpers/Game Class Off or On Lead** - Consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1<sup>st</sup> regardless of number of faults. Five faults for running course on-lead. Five faults for a knocked bar, and off-course. Fifteen faults for missed obstacle. Qualifying score of 200 earns one leg toward a JRTCA Jumpers/Game Certificate. Qualifying score sheets from Jumpers and Game may be mixed to apply for Jumpers/Game Certificate. Game must be a qualifying score with no faults. Judge may select a game from any agility venue. Scores from this class go toward the Championship and Reserve along with Agility II and Agility III.

**Class 127 - Agility High Score Champion & Reserve** – No Entry Fee. To be awarded to the highest scoring terrier and runner-up combining scores of classes Agility II & Agility III and qualifying no fault score in Jumpers/Game. Ties to be broken by fastest time.

## **Division F: Child & Youth**

- The youth handler must handle the same adult terrier in all Youth Division classes entered. No puppies please.
- Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year.
- Child & Youth entries must be JRTCA members.
- Entry form is on the back of the regular entry form.
- Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Note the points earned have changed.

**Class 128 - Child Handler** - Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell.

**Class 129 - Youth Handler** - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.

## **Division A: Conformation**

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections
- Exhibitors participating in the Working Classes must submit the appropriate JRTCA paperwork with entries. The judge may require a copy of The National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC Application, signed by a JRTCA Working Judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.

### **Section 1: Miscellaneous**

- Open to Adult Spayed or Neutered Terriers.
- Judged on breed standard unless otherwise noted.

Class 01 - Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier - *Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.*

Class 02 - Man's Best Friend - *Open to any Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on companionship, cuteness, personality, obedience and tricks. Not to be judged on breed standard. Non-sanctioned.*

Class 03 - Neutered Dog & Spayed Bitch

Class 04 - Best Veteran Dog & Bitch - *Open to any JRT six years and plus. Judged on the breed standard and condition of the terrier.*

Class 05 - Senior Dog & Bitch - *Open to any JRT 9 years or older. Judged on the breed standard and condition of the terrier. Non-Sanctioned.*

Class 06 - Florida Bred - *Open to any JRT bred in the State of Florida.*

### **Suitability/Judges Choice**

- Open to adult spayed & neutered terriers.
- The judge will place the dog he/she would choose to take hunting to each of the quarry below.

Class 07 - Suitability to Red Fox

Class 08 - Suitability to Groundhog

Class 09 - Suitability to Raccoon/Badger

Class 10 - Tool Box Class - *Open to handler with three adult Jack Russell Terriers at side; one suitable to each quarry (Fox, Groundhog, Raccoon/Badger). Placement based on the group the judge would choose to take hunting.*

### **Section 2: 4 up to 6 Month Puppy Conformation**

Class 11 - Dog Pups - *4 up to 6 months, Smooth*

Class 12 - Dog Pups - *4 up to 6 months, Rough/Broken*

Class 13 - Bitch Pups - *4 up to 6 months, Smooth*

Class 14 - Bitch Pups - *4 up to 6 months, Rough/Broken*

Class 15 - Best 4 up to 6 Month Puppy & Reserve - *No Entry Fee. Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners of class 11 thru 14.*

### **Section 3: 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Conformation**

Class 16 - Dog Pups - 6 up to 9 months, Smooth

Class 17 - Dog Pups - 6 up to 9 months, Rough/Broken

Class 18 - Dog Pups - 9 up to 12 months, Smooth

Class 19 - Dog Pups - 9 up to 12 months, Rough/Broken

**Class 20 - Best Dog Puppy & Reserve** - No Entry Fee. Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners of class 16 thru 19.

Class 21 - Bitch Pups - 6 up to 9 months, Smooth

Class 22 - Bitch Pups - 6 up to 9 months, Rough/Broken

Class 23 - Bitch Pups - 9 up to 12 months, Smooth

Class 24 - Bitch Pups - 9 up to 12 months, Rough/Broken

**Class 25 - Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve** - No Entry Fee. Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners of class 21 thru 24.

**Class 26 - Puppy Conformation Champion & Reserve** - No Entry Fee. Open to the best Dog Puppy and Reserve and the Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve.

## **Division E: AGILITY**

- All Terriers must be one year of age to compete in JRTCA Agility.
- Flat buckle collars only, no dangling objects, six-foot leads only, in On-Lead Classes. No collars in Off-Lead classes. Table not used.
- No cross-entering between Novice On-Lead to Agility I. Agility I may not enter Agility II or Agility III. No cross entering between from Agility II or Agility III into Agility I.
- Any scores that are NON-QUALIFYING may be used for ribbon placement and Champion/Reserve. Any score that is eliminated will not be eligible for placement or Champion/Reserve.
- Agility practice runs will be available for \$2.00 per run, payable at the Agility ring.
- Free practice runs for child/youth handlers, with instruction available.

- Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging, or be on file with Sunshine State JRTCA
- Cross- entering is not permitted between certificate classes.
- For all classes, after the terrier reaches the quarry, the terrier must work the full time required without a break in work. Work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining, biting at the bars. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from the quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself.

Class 95 - Pre-Novice Puppy - Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in this class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. The puppy has one minute to reach the quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry reached; when quarry is reached must work continuously for a full 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).

Class 96 - Novice Puppy - Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. The puppy has one minute to reach the quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).

Class 97 - Novice Adult - Open to Jack Russells one year and older, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Adult Class at this trial. The dog has one minute to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).

Class 98 - Open Puppy - Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% in a novice G-T-G class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously scored 100% in THIS class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the additional entry fee, move up to **Puppy Championship class at this trial**. The puppy has 30 seconds to reach the quarry; may leave the earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

Class 99 - Open Shorties (Non-Sanctioned) - Open to Jack Russell terrier under 10". 30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave tunnel once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.
