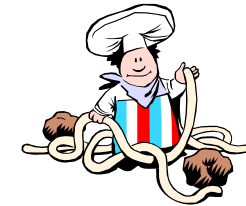

## Division C: Go-To-Ground

- Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial.
- Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging, or be on file with Sunshine State JRTC
- Cross-entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

### Class 96 Pre-Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in this class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. The puppy has one minute to reach the quarry, may leave earth and re-enter several times. The puppy must work the quarry for 15 seconds

### Class 97 Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. The puppy has one minute to reach the quarry, may leave earth and re-enter several times and must work the quarry for 30 seconds.

### Class 98 Novice Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year and older, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Adult Class at this trial. The dog has one minute to reach the quarry, may leave the earth and re-enter several times and must work the quarry for 30 seconds

### Class 99 Open Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% in a novice G-T-G class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. **Not open to any puppies which have previously scored 100% in THIS class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the additional entry fee, move up to Puppy Championship class at this trial.** The puppy has 30 seconds to reach the quarry, may leave the earth once and re-enter, work quarry for one minute.

### Class 100 Open Shorties (Non-Sanctioned)

Open to Jack Russell terrier under 10". 30 seconds to reach quarry, may leave tunnel once and re-enter, must work quarry 1 minute.

### Class 101 Open Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year and older, which have scored 100% in a Novice G-T-G class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Terrier has 30 seconds to reach the quarry, may leave earth once and re-enter, must work quarry for one minute.

### Class 102 SHORTIE Championship Class (Non-Sanctioned)

Open to Jack Russell terrier under 10". 30 seconds to reach quarry, may not leave the earth, must work the quarry for 1 minute. 1<sup>st</sup> Champion, 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve.

### Class 103 Puppy Championship Class

Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% in Open G-T-G at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies may move up to this class on the same day as qualifying in Open G-T-G upon payment of additional entry fee. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet must be submitted with a pre-entry or shown to den steward at the time of the class. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners will be Puppy G-T-G Champion and Reserve. 30 seconds to reach the quarry, may leave earth once and re-enter, must work quarry for one minute.

## Section 3: 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 22. Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, Smooth

Class 27. Puppy Conformation Champion & Reserve. Open to the best Dog Puppy and Reserve and the Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve. No entry fee.

## Section 4: Family

Class 28 Family Class Open to dam or sire with at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Stud Dog & Brood Bitch must be intact. Offspring may in intact or Spayed/neutered. The Family Pride perpetual trophy presented on SATURDAY.

## Section 5: JRTCA Working Terrier Conformation

Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Terriers entering the Working Section may not cross enter the Open Section; no cross entering within the Working Section. Classes may be combined by size and coat if entries warrant.

Class 29 Bronze Medallion Dog Open to any dog, which has earned the JRTCA bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field

Class 30 Working Terrier Dogs, 10" up to 12 1/2", Smooth

Class 31 Working Terrier Dogs, 10" up to 12 1/2", Rough/Broken

Class 32 Working Terrier Dogs, over 12 1/2" up to 15", Smooth

Class 33 Working Terrier Dogs, over 12 1/2" up to 15", Rough/Broken

Class 34 Best Working Dog & Reserve,

Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners of classes 29 thru 33. No entry fee.

Class 35 Bronze Medallion Bitch, Open to any bitch which has earned the JRTCA bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field

Class 36 Working Terrier Bitches, 10" up to 12 1/2", Smooth

Class 37 Working Terrier Bitches, 10" up to 12 1/2", Rough/Broken

Class 38 Working Terrier Bitches, over 12 1/2" up to 15", Smooth

Class 39 Working Terrier Bitches, over 12 1/2" up to 15", Rough/Broken

Class 40 Best Working Bitch & Reserve,

Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners of class 35 thru 39. No entry fee.

Class 41 JRTCA Working Terrier Champion & Reserve, Open to Best Working Dog & Reserve and Best Working Bitch & Reserve. No entry fee.

## Section 6: Open Adult Conformation

### Class 42 Bred By Exhibitor Dog

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 43 Dogs, 1 year & older, 10" up to 12 1/2", Smooth

Class 44 Dogs, 1 year & older, 10" up to 12 1/2", Rough/Broken

Class 45 Dogs, 1 year & older, over 12 1/2" up to 15", Smooth

Class 46 Dogs, 1 year & older, over 12 1/2" up to 15", Rough/Broken

### Class 47 Best Open Dog & Reserve,

Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners of class 42 thru 46. No entry fee.

### Class 48 Bred By Exhibitor Bitch

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 49 Bitches, 1 year & older, 10" up to 12 1/2", Smooth

Class 50 Bitches, 1 year & older, 10" up to 12 1/2", Rough/Broken

Class 51 Bitches, 1 year & older, Over 12 1/2" up to 15", Smooth

Class 52 Bitches, 1 year & older, Over 12 1/2" up to 15", Rough/Broken

### Class 53 Best Open Bitch & Reserve,

Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners of class 48 thru 53. No entry fee.

Open to Best Open Dog & Reserve and Best Open Bitch & Reserve. No entry fee.

## Division B: Racing

- All Terriers, including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled.
- Basket muzzles only. No bright colored muzzles. Collars off.**
- All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
- No request for height measurement once racing has begun.
- Shorties, Adult terriers one year and older, up to 10", may not cross-enter into any sanctioned racing classes.
- Terriers MAY NOT cross-enter between Adult, Veteran & Senior classes.
- A DOG TAXI may be used to transport dogs from catch pen back to start box. YOU MAY OPT OUT OF THIS SERVICE BY INFORMING THE START TABLE STEWARDS.

## GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRT's in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family\*, Open or Working Conformation.  
**\*Note:** For Family Classes, Brood Bitches & Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA judge may not be shown under that judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or an member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth handling classes. If an Affiliate sponsored trial is chaired by Committee, all on the committee may enter their terriers in any phase of the competition..
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the Judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Only JRTCA height cards issued AFTER September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. *Exhibitors' participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground & Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.*
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. *No liberty leashes allowed.*
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRT's on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.

20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website([www.terrier.com](http://www.terrier.com)).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. THE JUDGES DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

Exit #354/Old #70 (Hwy. 27) Go NW on Hwy. 27 in Marion County, approximately 19 miles to Levy County C316 which is 1 mile past Levy County Line. Do not take C316 in Marion County. Go Left onto C316 to traffic light (2 miles).

Go Left onto SR 41 for 1 mile. Just past A & N Corporation, Go Right onto SW 7 St. (Watch for Horseman Park Signs). Show grounds on right. There will be SSJRTC Trial Signs Posted.

## **Division A: Conformation**

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections
- Exhibitors participating in the Working Classes must submit the appropriate JRTCA paperwork with entries. The judge may require a copy of The National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC Application, signed by a JRTCA Working Judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.

### **Section 1: Miscellaneous**

*Open to Adult Spayed or Neutered Terriers.*

*Judged on breed standard unless otherwise noted.*

A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the den steward at the time of the class. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners will be Under G-T-G Champion and Reserve. 30 seconds to reach the quarry, may not leave the earth, must work the quarry for one minute. No cross-entering with Veterans.*

### **Class 109 Seniors Over 12 1/2" up to 15" Championship Certificate**

**(Non-Sanctioned)** *Open to Jack Russells, 9 years and over, which hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the den steward at the time of the class. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners will be Over G-T-G Champion and Reserve 30 seconds to reach the quarry, may not leave the earth, must work the quarry for one minute. No cross-entering with Veterans.*

Class 116 Veteran Certificate Super Earth. Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 6 yrs. & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. **A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class.** First and Second Place Winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

### **Division E: AGILITY**

- ~ All Terriers must be one year of age to compete in JRTCA Agility.
- ~ Flat buckle collars only, no dangling objects, six-foot leads only, in On-Lead Classes. No collars in Off-Lead classes. Table not used.
- ~ No cross-entering between Novice and Advanced On-Lead classes, between on-lead and off-lead, or Starters and Agility 1. **Lower Certificate levels may compete in the higher certificate classes, but will not be awarded a Certificate in the higher level until the lower level has been achieved first.**
- ~ Agility practice runs will be available for \$2.00 per run, payable at the Agility ring.
- ~ Free practice runs for child/youth handlers, with instruction available.

#### Class 117 Novice On-Lead, Non-Certificate

Open to terriers that have not scored above 190 points in this class. This class is for the true beginner terrier, but the dog should have prior exposure to agility equipment. Handlers that drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles.

#### Class 118 Advanced On-Lead, Non-Certificate

Open to terriers that have previously achieved a score of 190 or better in Novice On-Lead. Course the same as Novice On-Lead with the addition of the see-saw.

#### Class 119 Starters Agility, Off-Lead

Open to any adult terriers who have NOT scored 190 or higher in Starters Agility. Course to include ramps, tunnels, various hurdles and seesaw. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg toward JRTCA Agility 1 Certificate.

#### Class 120 Agility I Certificate

Open to terriers that have previously earned the first leg of Agility 1 Certificate in Starters Off-Lead. The last two legs of Agility 1 Certificate are earned with two additional 190 qualifying scores in this class.

#### Class 121 Agility II Certificate

More difficult course to include all of the Agility 1 equipment plus two more hurdles and weave poles. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility 2 Certificate.

## **AGILITY continued...**

#### Class 122 Agility III Certificate

Most difficult course to finish with a “gamble” and include 12 weave poles. Must finish with a perfect score of 200 to earn one leg towards JRTCA Agility 3 certificate.

#### Class 123 Agility High Score Champion & Reserve

To be awarded to the highest scoring terrier and runner-up combining scores of class 121 & 122. No Entry Fee. Ties to be broken by fastest time.

#### Class 124 Jumpers Off or On Lead

Consists of, 12-78 jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1<sup>st</sup>, regardless of number of faults. Five faults for a knocked bar or off-course. Fifteen faults for missed obstacle. If competitor wishes to use a leash, add five points fault to the score for the use of a training aid. Qualifying score of 200 earns one leg toward a JRTCA Jumpers Certificate. May be split by height. “OPTIONAL”

### **Division F: Child & Youth**

- The youth handler must handle the same adult terrier in all Youth Division classes entered. No puppies please.
- Child/Youth exhibitor’s age is determined as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year.
- Child & Youth entries must be JRTCA members.
- Entry form is on the back of the regular entry form.
- Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Note the points earned have changed.

#### Class 125 Child Handler

Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child’s ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell.

#### Class 126 Youth Handler Conformation

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth’s ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.

#### Class 127 Youth Handler Go-To-Ground (Starts at 10:00 a.m.)

Open to any youth aged 10 to 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth’s ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot novice liner: time not to be considered.

#### Class 128 Youth Handler Agility (On-Lead)

Open to any youth aged 10 to 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth’s ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Agility. Time not to be considered.

### **Class 129 Youth Handler Agility (Off-Lead)**

Open to any youth aged 10 to 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Agility. Time not to be considered. **May NOT cross-enter in class 126.**

### **Class 130 Youth Handler High Score Champion & Reserve**

Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in class 126, 127 & 128 **OR** 129. The points are awarded as follows, 1<sup>st</sup> = 8 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 6 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 5 points, 4<sup>th</sup> = 4 points, 5<sup>th</sup> = 3points, 6<sup>th</sup> = 2points, and participation = 1 point. No Entry Fee.

## **Division G: Trailing & Locating**

- Free Practice on Saturday after competition
- The terrier is judged on its ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate & mark quarry.
- Bonus: 10 seconds off time if dog opens on quarry.
