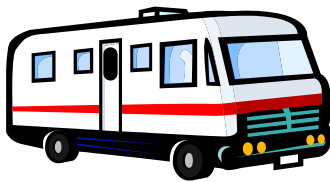
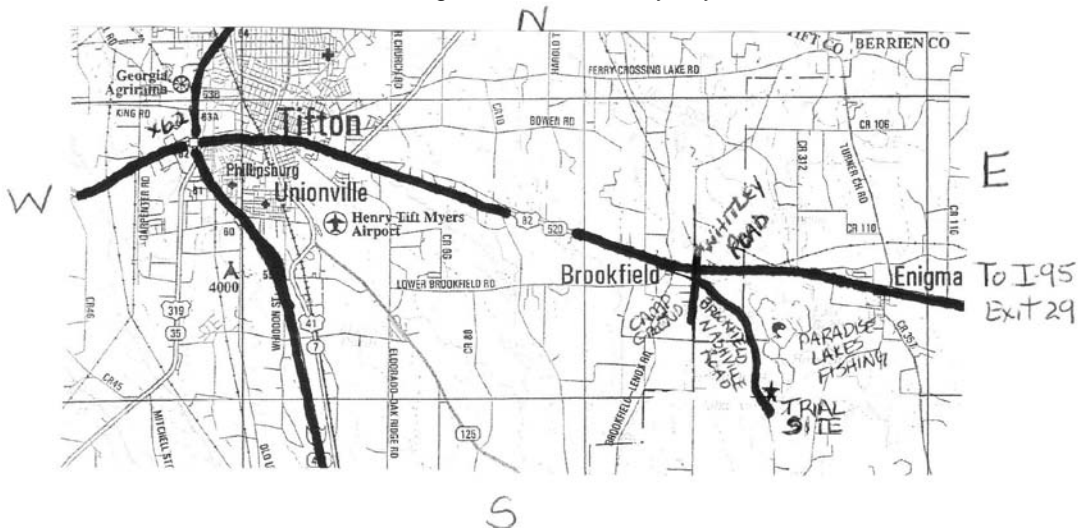
Go East on Hwy 82, approx 9 miles. Watch for convenience store called Brookfield General Store. Hwy 82 & Whitley.

YULETIDE HIGH POINT ADULT TERRIER AWARD

There will be an adult terrier high point and reserve awarded for the most TOTAL points of the weekend for the following categories: flat racing, hurdle racing, conformation=(one class-terrier's highest placement), go-to-ground, super earth, brush hunt and lure course. Please let the registration person know the morning of the trial when you pick up your packet; if your terrier will be competing in this event and they will keep track of the points. Good Luck and don't forget to enter all the events for the greatest chance!

1st -6 pts, 2nd -5 pts, 3rd -4 pts, 4th -3 pts, 5th -2 pts, 6th -1 pt.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10 - 15" JRTCA height standard (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For family classes; Brood bitches & Stud dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the Judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Current JRTCA height cards will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground & Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terriers.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
22. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.

DIVISION A: RACING

- All terriers including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled.
- Basket Muzzles only. No bright colored muzzles. Collars should be off.
- All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
- No request for height measurement once racing has begun.
- Shorties: Adult terriers one year and older, up to 10", may not cross-enter into any sanctioned racing classes.
- Terriers May Not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran & Senior classes.
- Your dogs may be transported by way of a golf cart with six crates from the catch area back to the start area. You may opt out of this service by telling the start box stewards.

Class 10 : Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 11 : Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 12 : Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 13 : Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 14 : Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 15 : Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 16 : Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"

Section 2. Steeplechase Races

- Puppy and Senior races over low hurdles, up to 8";
- Adult and Veteran Races over higher hurdles, over 8" up to 16".

- Class 17 : Pups, 4 up to 6 months, *non-sanctioned*
Class 18 : Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12½"
Class 19 : Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 20 : Pups, 9 up to 12 months, up to 12½"
Class 21 : Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 22 : Shorty, 1 yr & older, under 10", *non sanctioned*
Class 23 : Seniors, 9 Years and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 24 : Seniors, 9 Years and older, 12½" up to 15"
- Class 25 : Up to 12½" PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP. 6 – 12 MONTH. Open to 1st place winners of classes 2 & 4 and 18 & 20. *No entry fee.*
Class 26 : OVER 12½" up to 15" PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP. 6 – 12 MONTH. Open to 1st place winners of classes 3 & 5 and 19 & 21. *No entry fee.*
Class 27 : SHORTY CHAMPIONSHIP, 1 yr & older, under 10", *non sanctioned*
Open to 1st place winners of class 6 and 22. *No entry fee.*
Class 28 : 10" up to 12½" SENIOR RACING CHAMPIONSHIP. Open to 1st place winners of classes 7 and 23. *No entry fee.*
Class 29 : Over 12½" and up to 15" SENIOR RACING CHAMPIONSHIP. Open to 1st place winners of classes 8 and 24. *No entry fee.*
- Class 30 : Dogs, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 31 : Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 32 : Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 33 : Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 34 : Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 35 : Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 36 : Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 37 : Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 38 : **10" up to 12½" ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to 1st place winners of classes 9, 11, and 30, 32 . *No entry fee.*

Class 39 : **Over 12½" up to 15" ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to 1st place winners of classes 10,12, and 31,33 . *No entry fee.*

Class 40 : **VETERANS, 10" up to 12½", RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE**

Open to 1st place winners of classes 13,15 and 34,36 . *No entry fee.*

Class 41 : **VETERANS, over 12½" up to 15", RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE** Open to 1st place winners of classes 14,16 and 35,37 . *No entry fee.*

DIVISION B: Youth Division Class List

Child Handler, Youth Handler, and Youth Go-To-Ground are mandatory classes for every trial and must be the first conformation classes of the day. The Youth Division is listed as an entirely separate division. Please note that these classes are not included in any other division of the Trial Packet.

- The youth handler must handle the same adult terrier in all Youth Division classes entered. No puppies please.
- Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the calendar year.
- Child/Youth entries must be JRTCA members.
- Entry form is on the back of the regular entry form.
- Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
- Points are: 1st=8 pts., 2nd=6 pts., 3rd=5 pts., 4th= 3 pts., 5th=3 pts., 6th= 2 pts., & Participation=1 pt.

Class 42: **Child Handler**. Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell.

Class 43: **Youth Handler**. Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.

Class 44: **Youth Working Judge's Choice**. Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

Class 45: **Youth G-T-G**. Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.

Class 46: **YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE**

Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 43, 44 & 45.

DIVISION C: CONFORMATION

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working Classes must submit the appropriate JRTCA
- Paperwork with entries. The judge may require a copy of The National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC Application, signed by a JRTCA Working Judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.

Section 1: MISCELLANEOUS

- Open to any adult JRT including those spayed and neutered.
- Judged on breed standard; unless otherwise noted.

Class 47 : **Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier**. Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.

Class 48 : **Spayed/Neutered Terrier**. Open to any spayed/neutered JRT.

Class 49 : **Veteran Dog**. Open to any JRT dog over six years of age.

Class 50 : **Veteran Bitch**. Open to any JRT bitch over six years of age.

Class 51 : **BEST VETERAN TERRIER**. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 49 and 50.

Class 52 : **Companion Terrier**. Open to all JRTS. Judged on; companionship, cuteness, personality, obedience and tricks. Not to be judged on breed standard. *Non-sanctioned.*

SUITABILITY-JUDGE'S CHOICE

- Open to any adult JRT, including those which have been spayed/neutered. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each quarry listed below.

Class 53 : **Suitability to Red Fox.**

Class 54 : **Suitability to Groundhog.**

Class 55 : **Suitability to Raccoon/Badger.**

Class 56 : **Tool Box Class.** Open to handler with three adult Jack Russell Terriers at side; one suitable to each quarry (Fox, groundhog, raccoon/badger) Placement based on the group the judge would choose to take hunting.

Section 2: PUPPY CONFORMATION

4 UP TO 6 MONTH PUPPY CONFORMATION

Class 57 : Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months, smooth.

Class 58 : Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months, rough/broken.

Class 59 : Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months, smooth.

Class 60 : Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months, rough/broken.

Class 61 : **BEST 4 UP TO 6 MONTH PUPPY & RESERVE.** Open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of classes: 57, 58, 59, and 60. *No entry fee.*

6 UP TO 12 MONTH PUPPY CONFORMATION

Class 62 : Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months, smooth.

Class 63 : Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months, rough/broken.

Class 64 : Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months, smooth.

Class 65 : Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months, rough/broken.

Class 66 : **BEST 6-12 MONTH PUPPY DOG & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes: 62, 63, 64, and 65. *No entry fee.*

Class 67 : Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, smooth.

Class 68 : Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, rough/broken.

Class 69 : Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months, smooth.

Class 70 : Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months, rough/broken.

Class 71 : **BEST 6-12 MONTH PUPPY BITCH & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes: 67, 68, 69, and 70. *No entry fee.*

Class 72 : **PUPPY CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE.** Open to Best Dog Puppy & Reserve and Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve. *No entry fee.*

Section 3: FAMILY

Class 73 : **Stud Dog & Get.** Open to a sire with at least two, but not more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Stud Dog must be an intact male. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 74 : **Brood Bitch & Produce.** Open to a dam with at least two, but not more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Brood Bitch must be an intact female. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 75 : **BEST FAMILY & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners in classes 73 & 74. *No entry fee.*

Section 4: JRTCA WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION

- Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.
- Terriers entering the Working Section may **not** cross-enter into the Open Section; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working Section.
- Classes may be combined by height and coat type at the Trial Chairperson's discretion.

Class 76 : Bronze Medallion Dog. Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 77 : Working Terrier Dog, 10 up to 12½", smooth

Class 78 : Working Terrier Dog, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken

Class 79 : Working Terrier Dog, over 12½ up to 15", smooth

Class 80 : Working Terrier Dog, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken

Class 81 : **BEST WORKING TERRIER DOG & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 76 through 80. *No entry fee.*

Class 82 : Bronze Medallion Bitch. Open to any bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 83 : Working Terrier Bitch, 10 up to 12½", smooth

Class 84 : Working Terrier Bitch, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken

Class 85 : Working Terrier Bitch, over 12½ up to 15", smooth

Class 86 : Working Terrier Bitch, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken

Class 87 : **BEST WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 82 through 86. *No entry fee.*

Class 88 : **JRTCA WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE.** Open to Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve and Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve from Classes 81 and 88. *No entry fee.*

Section 5: OPEN ADULT CONFORMATION

- No cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section.
 - Cross-entering is **not** permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section.
- Class 89 : **Bred by Exhibitor Dog.** Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder *under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered* or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 90 : Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", smooth
- Class 91 : Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken
- Class 92 : Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", smooth
- Class 93 : Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken
- Class 94 : **BEST DOG & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 89 through 93. *No entry fee.*

Class 95 : **Bred by Exhibitor Bitch.** Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder *under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered* or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 96 : Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", smooth

Class 97 : Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken

Class 98 : Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", smooth

Class 99 : Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken

Class 100 : **BEST BITCH & RESERVE.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 95 through 99. *No entry fee.*

Class 101 : **BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE.** Open to Best Dog & Reserve and Best Bitch & Reserve. *No entry fee.*

DIVISION D: GO TO GROUND

- Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial.
- Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging.
- Cross-entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

Class 102 : Pre-Novice Puppy. Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; mark quarry for 15 seconds; may leave earth and re-enter.)

Class 103 : Novice Puppy: Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)

Class 104 : Novice Adult: Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. *Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial.* (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)

Class 105 : Open Puppy. Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. *Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial.* (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 106 : Open Adult. Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 107 : Open Shorty. Open to adult terriers under 10". Terrier may not cross enter into any other division. *Non-sanctioned*

Class 108 : Puppy Championship. Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 109 : 10 up to 12½" Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 110 : Over 12½ up to 15" Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½ up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 111 : 10 up to 12 ½" Veteran Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 112 : 12 ½ up to 15: Veteran Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)

Class 113 : 10 up to 12 ½" Senior Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.) *Non-sanctioned*

Class 114 : 12 ½ up to 15: Senior Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.) *Non-sanctioned*

FASTEST GO TO GROUND TIME PERPETUAL- there will be a perpetual trophy awarded to the fastest time in the 30 foot tunnel (this includes open adult & puppies) for the weekend.

This is awarded in memory of our beloved R. A. Trixie.

DIVISION E: SUPER EARTH GO TO GROUND

- 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth; work quarry for one minute. Classes may be combined as entries warrant.
- Sanctioned classes; check rules posted.

Class 115 : 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth

Class 116 : 10" up to 15" Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers 1 yr and older

Class 117 : 10" up to 15" Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers 6 yrs and older

Class 118 : Adult Certificate Super Earth. Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, *which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate*. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 119 : Veteran Certificate Super Earth. Open to Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older, *which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate*. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
